As the parent/guardian of a member of the Ohio Storm AAU Basketball team, we will conduct ourselves in a manner that will support the players and the Club.

- 1. I understand that my child has paid to learn the skills and concepts of basketball in an effective and respectful environment. The Coaching Staff will provide each player with a role on the team and ensure that every player plays in every tournament if they have met their obligations to the team and the club, although this does not mean that each player will play in every game or play the same amount of time.
 - a. We do not guarantee equal playing time on any team or at any event. Playing time for athletes is determined by attendance, attitude, effort, performance, the teams need at the moment, and is left solely to the discretion of the Coach.
- 2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players and coaches.
- 3. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all referees, league officials and parents at every game and event.
- 4. I will place the emotional and physical well being of all children on all teams ahead of my personal desire to win.
- 5. I will ask my child to treat all other players, coaches, referees, league officials, and parents with respect.
- 6. I will encourage my child to shake hands with the other team at the conclusion of games.
- 7. If I have a concern, I will talk to the coach at the appropriate time and place.
- 8. We request that you do not coach your child from the sidelines at practice or games. We do not want to put our players in a position of having to choose whom to listen to and to trust the coaches with that job.
